We provide a [Consultation](#) for up to one hour at no additional fee. We will discuss your concerns and answer any questions you may have in a step by step fashion. We make sure that we understand your preferences for each stage of your Reception. It may help to write your questions down as you think of them and bring them to your consultation. You also may want to start thinking about the order of events for your reception. You don't have to know everything you will want at the first meeting. We do however ask that you chose your songs at least 3 weeks in advance of your Reception. This insures us time to purchase any special music that you may need.

Our [Wedding Planner](#) is on the web site for your convenience too! You can print the planner, fill it out and return it to us with your deposit. Take your time filling out the planner. Planning ahead of time will ensure that things flow smoothly. [Always call first for availability!](#)

We regularly update our music library offering our customers 1000's of songs to enjoy. The customer is welcome to bring additional regular format CD's for their enjoyment. Our library consists of music from the Big Band Era to the Present.

We make it a point to be where we are supposed to be, when we are supposed to be! In the event that we are already committed on



the date you are looking for, we will help you find the next best, reputable DJ possible.

We have a selection of [Wedding Planning Books](#), wedding magazines, wedding catalogs, wilton cake decorating books, etc. that you are welcome

to look through during your consultation while getting your ideas together.

We are available to provide the music at your wedding as well as your reception if they are both at the same location. Some times we can do both if the locations are different, but within about 30 minutes of each other.

We often go to the [Wedding Rehearsal](#) when we are doing the ceremony music. If you would like the DJ to attend your rehearsal, just tell us ahead of time so we can check our schedule. This is a good time for the DJ to see where to set up ahead of time and to find Electrical Outlets etc. This also helps with the timing of the music.

We will announce your [Wedding Party](#) if you wish. There is a place on the Wedding Planner to write in the name and add any pronunciations that you think may be necessary. We will also provide a microphone to the Best Man or others that wish to [Toast](#) the Wedding Couple.

We meet your agenda, not ours. The [DJ](#) will really get your reception rolling and participate or he will play background music. You just tell us what mood you want to set!

If your wedding and reception will be held in a [Gated Community](#), please call ahead and gain clearance for the DJ at the gate. Doing this ahead of time will ensure that your DJ can enter early and be set up before most of your guests arrive! We like to set up approximately one hour before we are supposed to start the music.

A great way to get everyone up and dancing is a Group Dance!

Wedding Gown Preservation

Wedding gowns should be cleaned and preserved as soon after the big day as possible. The reason for this is because any kind of food or beverage that may have come in contact with the fabric will start a chemical reaction that can leave a tanning stain or worse yet take the color in spots.

After the gown is cleaned and treated it is folded around acid free tissue and laid elegantly into a special inner box that has a window inset for later viewing. This inner box is then placed into the outer box for protection and storage.

The process depending on the gown usually takes from one to two weeks, but provides a lifetime of memories.

Official State dance: The shag is the official dance of the State.

Official State waltz: "The Richardson Waltz" is designated as the official state waltz.

Official State song: "South Carolina On My Mind" is designated as an official state song to help inspire pride in our State and improve the quality of life among all South Carolinians, and to promote the image of South Carolina beyond our borders by further developing tourism and industry through the attraction of vacationers, prospective investors, and new residents.

Official State music: The spiritual is the official music of the State.

Official state popular music: Beach music is designated as the official state popular music of South Carolina.

Official American Folk Dance: The square dance is the official American Folk Dance of the State.
